Department Highlights

Center for Sexuality & Gender Diversity

Reported **301 student engagements** from educational, social, awareness, and other programs, a **6% decrease** from Feb. 2022.¹

Counseling & Psychological Services

Surveyed student clients to reveal **95% of respondents** agreed they would recommend CAPS to a friend.²

Emily Taylor Center for Women & Gender Equity

Collaborated with SURGE to host **125 students** at the Let's Talk About Sex Trivia Night event.

Health Education Resource Office

Hosted **two CPR classes** on campus, certifying **13 KU community members**.

Hilltop Child Development Center

Provided childcare to **309 children**, a **3% increase** from Feb. 2022.³

KU Recreation Services

Recorded **44,878 student interactions** at Ambler Student Recreation Fitness Center, a **33% increase** from Feb. 2022.⁴

■ KU Student Housing

Reported a Fall 2022 **3.45 GPA average** for undergrad staff (RAs, Proctors, Food Board Members). **Sixty percent** achieved a **3.50 GPA or higher.**⁵

Legal Services for Students

Assisted **152 students and international staff** in preparing their 2022 income tax returns through tax workshops.

Sexual Assault Prevention & Education Center

Provided 13 educational programs and awareness events, an 86% increase from Feb. 2022.⁶

Sorority & Fraternity Life

Reported a **3.35 GPA average** for the sorority and fraternity community for Fall 2022, a **4% increase** from Fall 2021.⁷

Student Conduct & Community Standards

Engaged 25 Multicultural Greek Council members through a program on conflict resolution skills.

Student Money Management Services

Provided **593 students** with presentations and consultations, a **142% increase** from Feb. 2022.8

Student Support & Case Management

Received **1,097 Campus Cupboard student visitors**, a **166% increase** from Feb. 2022.⁹

Student Involvement & Leadership Center

Conducted **19 SILC Peer Outreach Team** consultations, educational programs, and awareness events, receiving rave reviews.¹⁰

Watkins Health Services

Administered **235 immunizations**, including **24 COVID-19** and **30 flu** vaccinations, an **18% decrease** from Feb. 2022.¹¹
