#### **Department Highlights**

## Center for Sexuality & **Gender Diversity**

Engaged 338 people through educational, social, awareness, and other programs, a 32% increase from the prior year.<sup>1</sup>

#### Counseling & Psychological Services

Provided 22 triage and urgent care appointments to patients, an 87% increase from the prior year.<sup>2</sup>

### Health Education Resource Office

Supported 600 students across six Stress Busting Study Break events in December.

#### Hilltop Child Development Center

Employed 61 students on staff, an 11% increase from the prior year.<sup>3</sup>

#### KU Memorial Unions

Enrolled **28 students** in the course LDST 320: How to plan (almost) anything, a 47% increase from the prior year.<sup>4</sup>

#### KU Recreation Services

Hosted 49.328 students at ASFRC. a **190% increase** from the prior year.<sup>5</sup>

#### KU Student Housing

Re-branded weekly newsletter, KU Housing News, was opened by more than 2,350 students, a 48% open rate.<sup>6</sup>

#### Legal Services for Students

Hired 10 student tax interns to help the department reach its goal of assisting in the filing of 1,100 income tax returns.

#### Office of Multicultural Affairs

Welcomed 35 students to the OMA Spring Open House, a 17% increase from the prior year.<sup>7</sup>

#### Sexual Assault Prevention & **Education Center**

Trained 94% of students through the online sexual harassment program, a **2% increase** from the prior year.<sup>8</sup>

#### Sorority & Fraternity Life

Resumed holding SFL Advance in person with 61 student leaders in attendance, a 13% decrease from the prior year.9

#### Student Conduct & **Community Standards**

Adjudicated 210 student conduct cases, a 13% decrease from the prior year.<sup>10</sup>

#### Student Money Management Services

Provided 315 students with presentations and consultations, a 212% increase from the prior year.<sup>11</sup>

# Student Support & **Case Management**

Received 138 student referrals. a **45% increase** from the prior year. 12

## Student Involvement & **Leadership Center**

Hosted 83 student organizations at the Winterfest Involvement Fair, a **186% increase** from the prior year.<sup>13</sup>

#### Watkins Health Services

Provided health information and services to 160 international students. a 47% increase from the prior year. 14
